



Griffin set for title bid with MTECH Ferrari

International GT Ace Matt Griffin is aiming for the British GT Title next season with the MTECH Ferrari team.

The Irishman took a British GT victory with MTECH this season and 3 consecutive pole positions but could not complete a full campaign due to International GT Commitments. Now he will contest full year with team regular Duncan Cameron.

“I am delighted to continue with MTECH in the British GT”
Added Griffin “ Completing the deal this early will put the team in a great situation and will enable us to really push for the championship. I plan to add some other racing activities to this but winning the British GT Championship is the top of priority list. It is a top team which is growing so its great to be involved with them.”

“We can confirm that Matt will be doing a complete season with us next year,” revealed team boss Mike Edmonds. “Obviously we are very pleased about that, and we think it puts us potentially in a championship-winning position, not least because we have now ironed out a lot of the early-season gremlins we had this year.”

MTECH Racing has just returned from a successful foray to the Catalunya GT Open races at Barcelona, in which Griffin and Cameron scored a notable GTS category win.

The team will begin pre season testing in January 2010 in preparation for the season.
